

HANCOCK HIGH SCHOOL
2011-2012 HALL OF FAME REQUIREMENTS

Hancock High School's Hall of Fame represents a select group of senior students who have outstanding academic records, leadership skills, character, citizenship, and community service.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Students must have attended Hancock High School the full junior and senior years.
2. No more than 5% of the senior class will be accepted into the Hall of Fame.
3. Students will be selected by a school staff committee. The following criteria items may be used: applications, attendance records, discipline records, and academic records. These selections are based on the student application; thus, the committee decisions are final.
4. Teacher and club/athletic sponsors will have an opportunity to verify membership status and awards documented by the applicant.
5. The student must not have failed any subject during any high school year 9-12.
6. The student must not have had more than 6 undocumented absences during the fall semester or excessive unexcused tardies.
7. The student may not have had an out of school suspension during their high school years or engage in any action that does not exemplify good behavior or school board policy.
8. Students need to give careful consideration to ensure the applications are complete prior to the submission of the application by the deadline date of the last school day of the first semester.
9. The points for Hall of Fame can be found on page 22-23 in the 2011-2012 HHS handbook.
10. Completed applications must be turned in to Mrs. Palombo or Miss Lovelace. The original and 2 copies must be provided. Incomplete or incorrectly completed applications will not be considered. There are no extensions on the deadline.

Important Dates:

January 18, 2012-Hall of Fame applicant meeting with Miss Lovelace

January 27, 2012-Hall of Fame applications due by 2pm to Miss Lovelace or Mrs. Palombo

January 30-February 3, 2012-Hall of Fame will be announced during this week

Guidelines:

1. All applications and 2 copies must be turned in complete with all signatures on or before 2:00pm on **January 27, 2012.**
2. No attachments are allowed other than the sealed transcript. Only information on the application will be reviewed and verified by student records.
3. A transcript must be submitted with the Hall of Fame application. The transcript must be placed in an envelope, sealed and signed along the seal by a guidance counselor.
4. Points are awarded based SOLELY on information on the application. Please double check all categories. Applications will not be given back to correct if the student leaves something off.
4. Once the application is turned in, it will not be returned and you may make no changes to it.
5. Once teacher verification has occurred, students may be asked to meet with the committee if irregularities are found. If irregularities are found, the application will be marked void.
6. If you have any questions, see Mrs. Palombo or Miss Lovelace during activity time only.
